



TACHYDROMOS is a Greek daily newspaper. On 1st April 2016, they wrote an article about the program Life Pisa and the successful results. In particular, they mentioned how the allergic problems of *Thaumetopoea pityocampa* were decreased in the areas of Agios Konstantinos park and Goritsa (the places that some actions of the program took place). In addition, they indicate that the number of visible larvae was drastically reduced since last year, and that Professor Christos Athanassiou and his group from the University of Thessaly in collaboration with the Municipality of Volos, significantly reduced the problem of the moths. In contrast, to another city in Greece, Larisa, it took several unnecessary actions to control pine moth, and they cut 20 pine trees, with the concomitant negative criticism.
